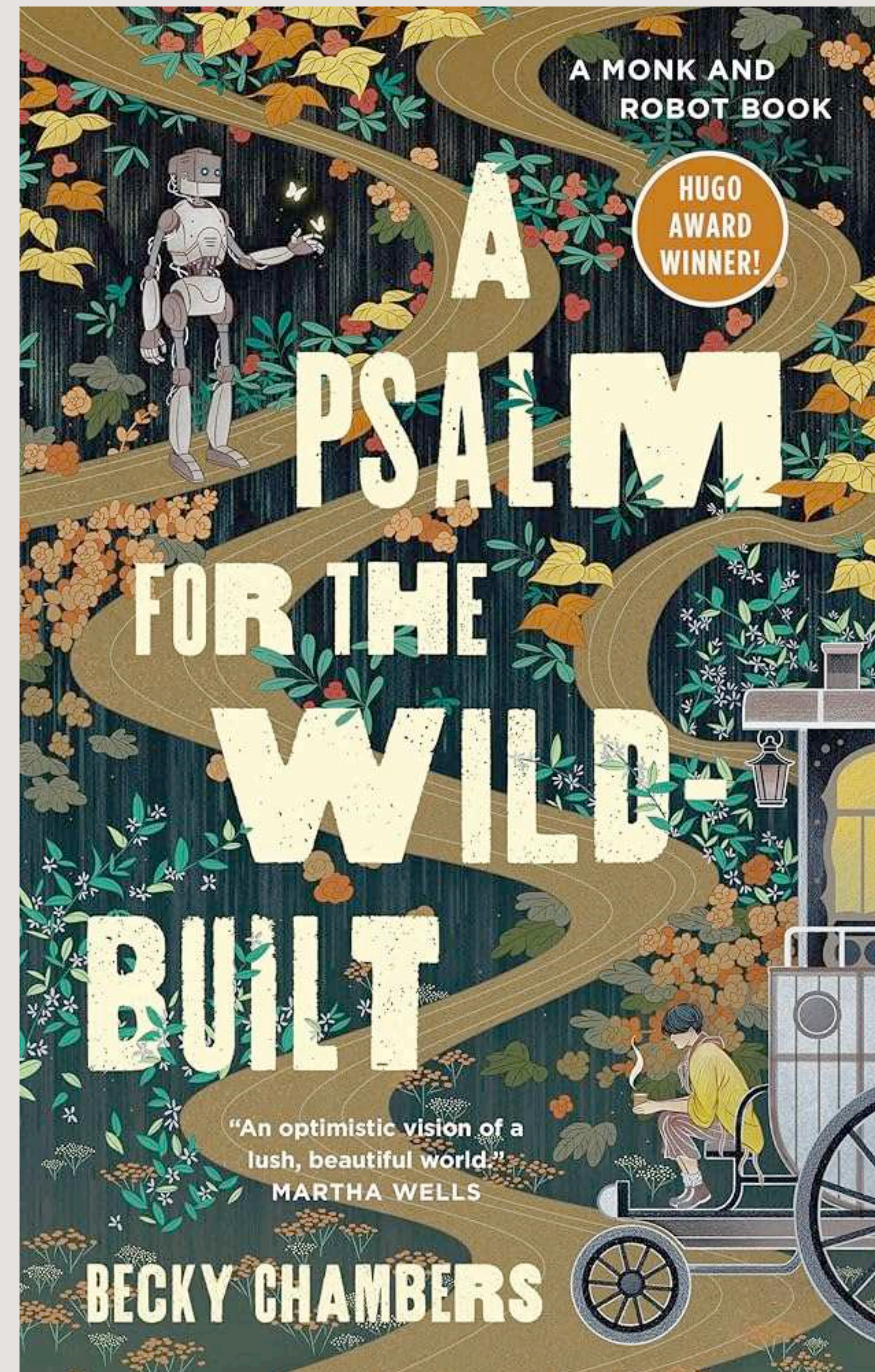

“It’s pretty here,” Dex said. “I wouldn’t have imagined I’d say that about a place like this, but—”

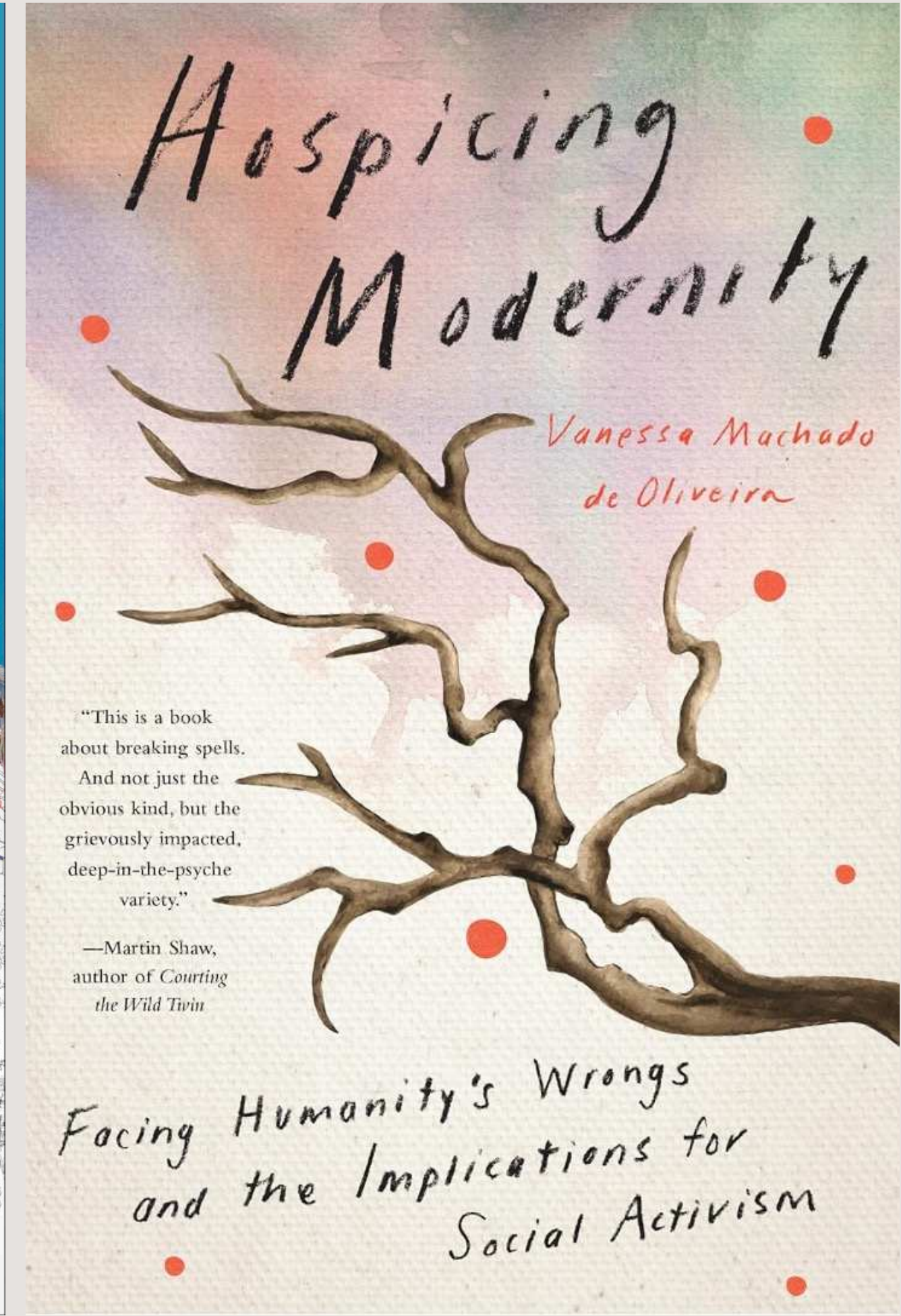
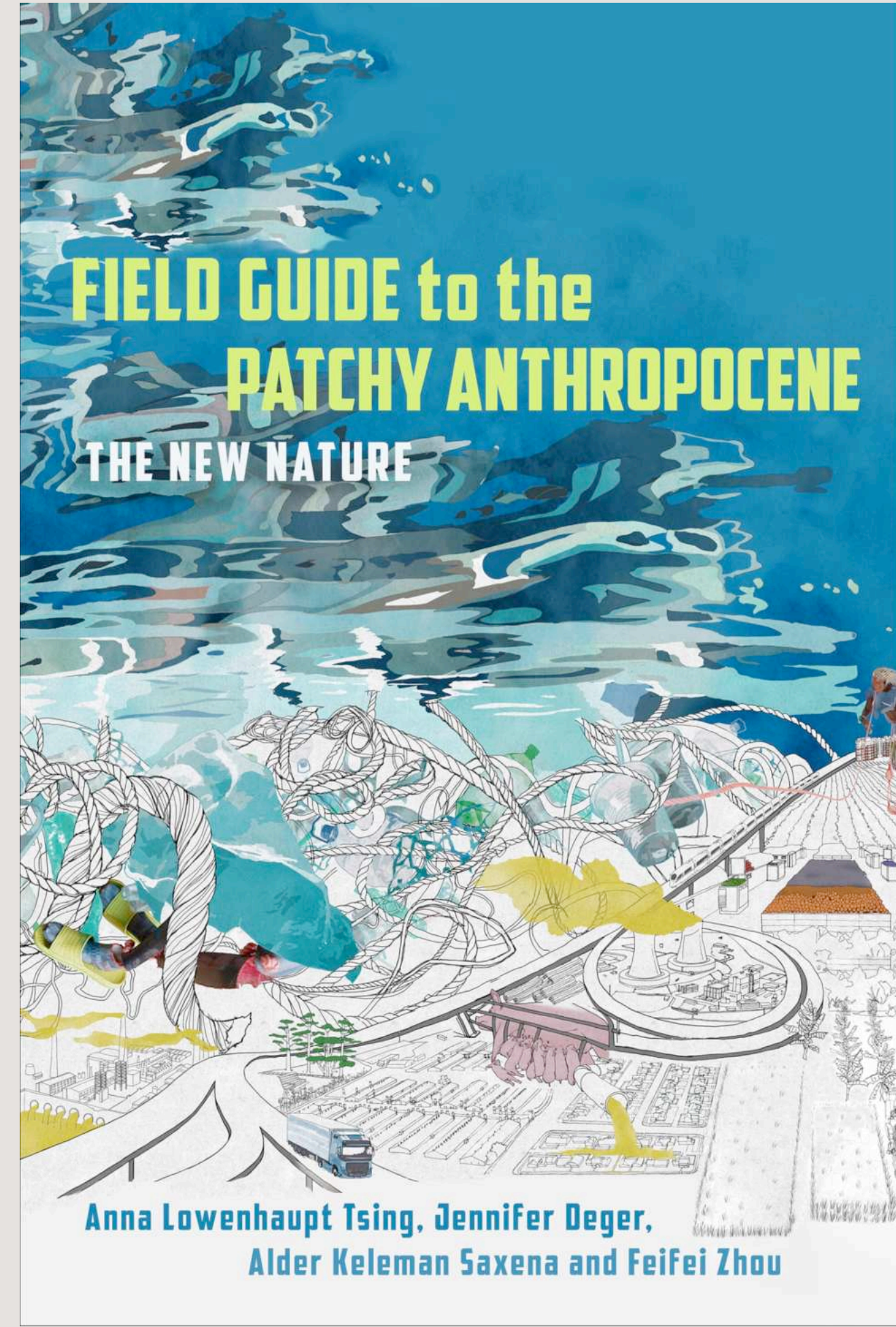
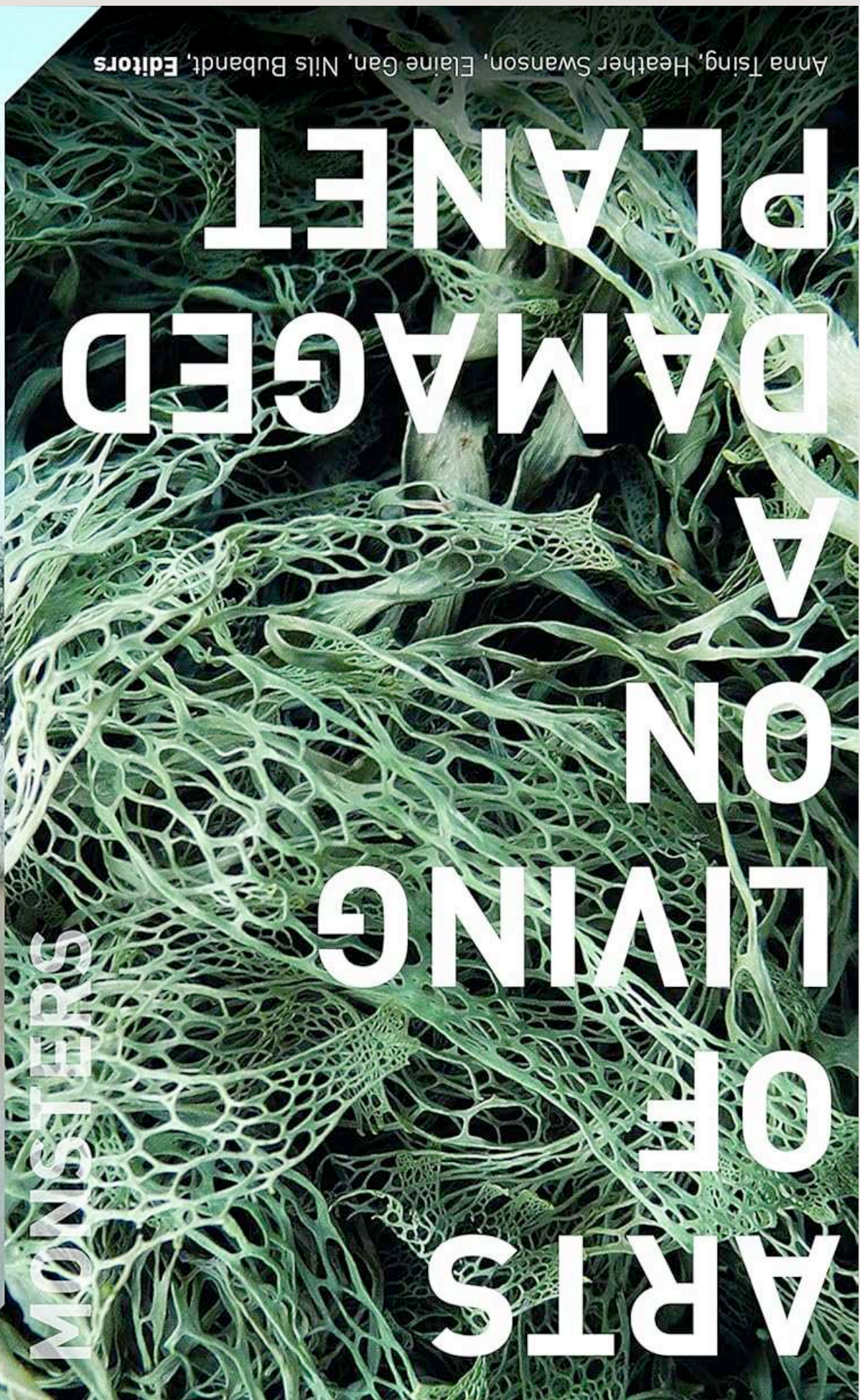
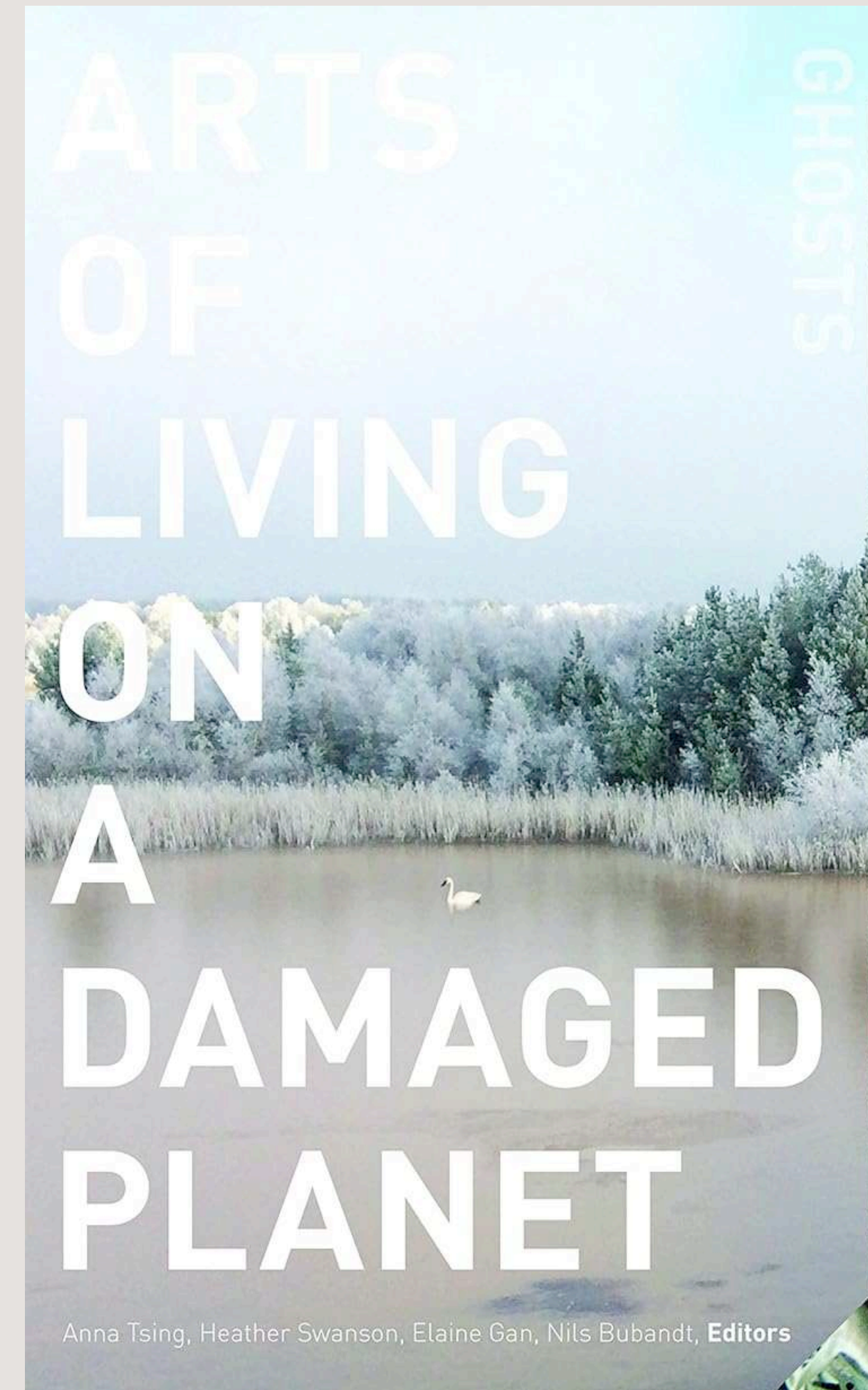
“Yes, it is,” Mossicap said, as if making a decision within itself. “It is. Dying things often are.”



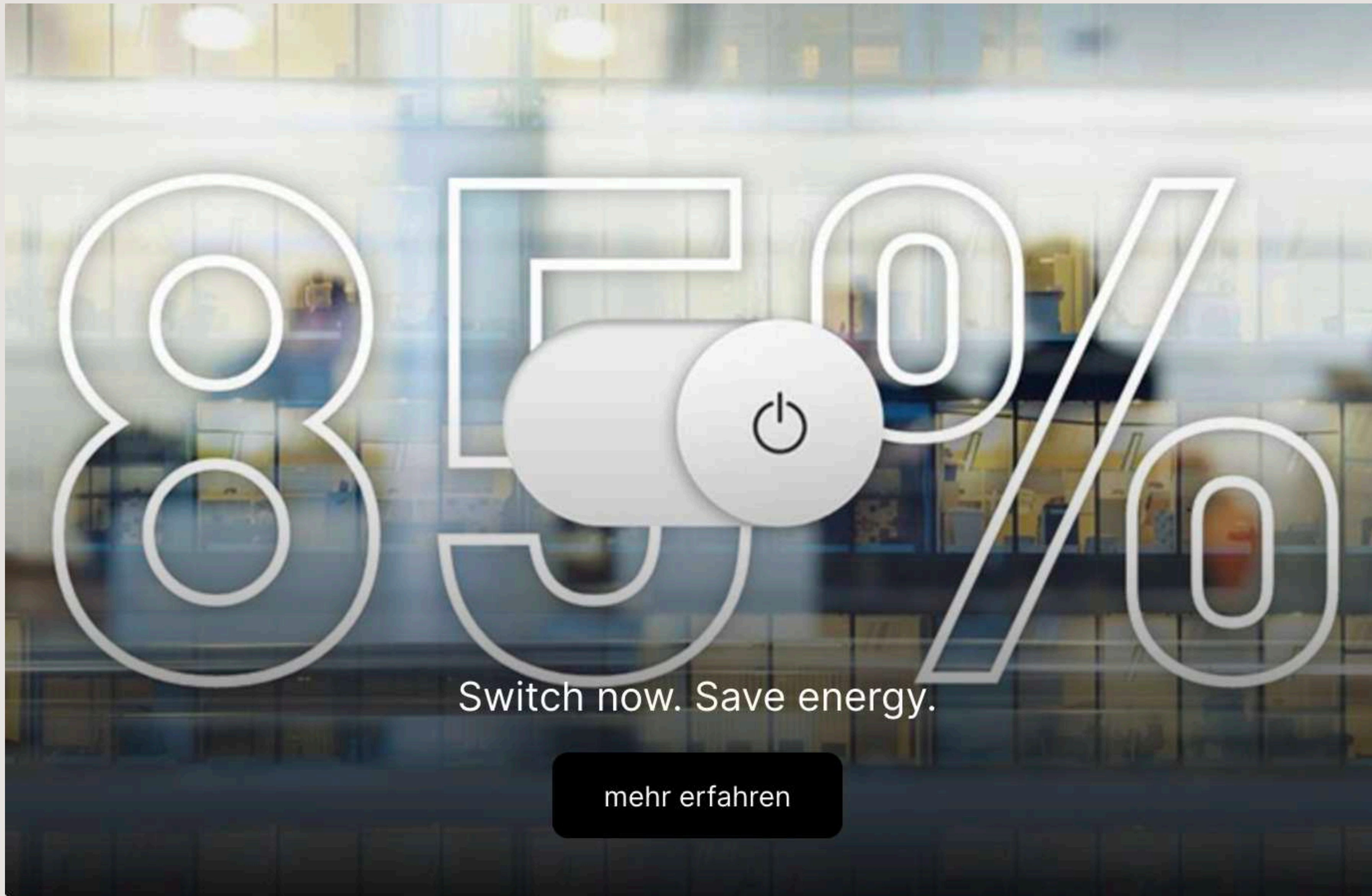
Somehow, in the midst of ruins, we must maintain enough curiosity to notice the strange and wonderful as well as the terrible and terrifying.
